1	Turning Water into Wine	John 2:1-11	Jesus transforms water in six stone jars into high-quality wine at a wedding feast.	Prākāmya, Īśitva	Prākāmya for fulfilling the desire for wine through transformation; Īśitva for controlling and altering the elements (water to wine).
2	Healing an Official's Son	John 4:43-54	Jesus heals a royal official's dying son from a distance without physical presence.	Prāpti, Īśitva	Prāpti for reaching and affecting a distant person; Īśitva for exerting lordship over illness and life forces remotely.
3	Driving Out an Evil Spirit from a Man in Capernaum	Mark 1:21-27; Luke 4:31-36	Jesus commands a demon to leave a possessed man in a synagogue, restoring him.	Vaśitva, Īśitva	Vaśitva for subjugating the demon's will; Īśitva for supreme control over supernatural entities.
4	Healing Peter's Mother-in-Law	Matthew 8:14-15; Mark 1:29-31; Luke 4:38-39	Jesus rebukes a high fever, instantly healing Simon Peter's mother-in-law.	Īśitva	Lordship over disease and bodily functions, commanding the fever to leave.
5	Healing Many Sick and Oppressed at Evening	Matthew 8:16-17; Mark 1:32-34; Luke 4:40-41	Jesus heals numerous people of illnesses and drives out demons after sunset.	Īśitva, Vaśitva	Īśitva for control over physical ailments; Vaśitva for dominating demons.
6	First Miraculous Catch of Fish	Luke 5:1-11	Jesus instructs fishermen to cast nets, resulting in an overwhelming catch after a fruitless night.	Prāpti, Prākāmya	Prāpti for obtaining abundant fish; Prākāmya for realizing the desire for a successful catch against natural odds.
7	Cleansing a Man with Leprosy	Matthew 8:1-4; Mark 1:40-45; Luke 5:12-14	Jesus touches a leper, instantly cleansing his skin disease.	Īśitva	Control over bodily matter and disease, purifying the skin.
8	Healing a Centurion's Paralyzed Servant	Matthew 8:5-13; Luke 7:1-10	Jesus heals a servant from paralysis and pain remotely, based on the centurion's faith.	Prāpti, Īśitva	Prāpti for distant access; Īśitva for lordship over paralysis.

9	Healing a Paralytic Lowered from the Roof	Matthew 9:1-8; Mark 2:1-12; Luke 5:17-26	Jesus forgives sins and heals a paralyzed man, who then walks.	Īsitva	Supreme control over physical disabilities, restoring mobility.
10	Healing a Man's Withered Hand on the Sabbath	Matthew 12:9-14; Mark 3:1-6; Luke 6:6-11	Jesus commands a man with a shriveled hand to stretch it out, restoring it.	Īsitva	Lordship over deformed limbs, commanding restoration.
11	Raising a Widow's Son in Nain	Luke 7:11-17	Jesus touches a bier and raises a dead young man back to life.	Īsitva	Absolute control over life and death, reviving the deceased.
12	Calming a Storm on the Sea	Matthew 8:23-27; Mark 4:35-41; Luke 8:22-25	Jesus rebukes wind and waves, instantly stilling a violent storm.	Īsitva	Lordship over natural elements (wind and water).
13	Casting Demons into a Herd of Pigs	Matthew 8:28-33; Mark 5:1-20; Luke 8:26-39	Jesus expels demons from two men into pigs, which then drown.	Vaśitva, Īsitva	Vaśitva for subjugating demons; Īsitva for directing them into animals.
14	Healing a Woman with an Issue of Blood	Matthew 9:20-22; Mark 5:25-34; Luke 8:42-48	A woman touches Jesus' cloak and is healed of chronic bleeding.	Īsitva	Control over bodily afflictions through his presence.
15	Raising Jairus' Daughter	Matthew 9:18, 23-26; Mark 5:21-24, 35-43; Luke 8:40-42, 49-56	Jesus takes a dead girl's hand and raises her to life.	Īsitva	Lordship over death, restoring life.
16	Healing Two Blind Men	Matthew 9:27-31	Jesus touches the eyes of two blind men, restoring their sight.	Īsitva	Control over sensory organs and defects.
17	Healing a Man Unable to Speak	Matthew 9:32-34	Jesus casts out a demon causing muteness, enabling speech.	Vaśitva, Īsitva	Vaśitva for controlling the demon; Īsitva for restoring speech.
18	Healing an Invalid at Bethesda	John 5:1-15	Jesus commands a man lame for 38 years to walk, healing him.	Īsitva	Lordship over chronic disability.

19	Feeding the 5,000	Matthew 14:13-21; Mark 6:30-44; Luke 9:10-17; John 6:1-15	Jesus multiplies five loaves and two fish to feed thousands.	Prākāmya, Prāpti	Prākāmya for realizing abundant food; Prāpti for obtaining it from limited resources.
20	Walking on Water	Matthew 14:22-33; Mark 6:45-52; John 6:16-21	Jesus walks across a stormy sea to his disciples' boat.	Laghimā, Īsitva	Laghimā for defying gravity on water; Īsitva for control over elements.
21	Healing Many Sick in Gennesaret	Matthew 14:34-36; Mark 6:53-56	People touch Jesus' cloak and are healed of various illnesses.	Īsitva	Broad lordship over diseases through his presence.
22	Healing a Gentile Woman's Demon-Possessed Daughter	Matthew 15:21-28; Mark 7:24-30	Jesus expels a demon from a girl remotely.	Prāpti, Vaśitva	Prāpti for distant action; Vaśitva for subjugating the demon.
23	Healing a Deaf and Mute Man	Mark 7:31-37	Jesus spits, touches the man's tongue and ears, healing him.	Īsitva	Control over sensory impairments.
24	Feeding the 4,000	Matthew 15:32-39; Mark 8:1-13	Jesus multiplies seven loaves and a few fish to feed thousands.	Prākāmya, Prāpti	Similar to feeding 5,000: fulfilling and obtaining food.
25	Healing a Blind Man at Bethsaida	Mark 8:22-26	Jesus spits on a blind man's eyes and lays hands, restoring sight in stages.	Īsitva	Lordship over blindness.
26	Healing a Man Born Blind	John 9:1-12	Jesus makes mud with saliva, anoints eyes, and sends the man to wash, granting sight.	Īsitva	Control over congenital defects.
27	Healing a Boy with an Unclean Spirit	Matthew 17:14-20; Mark 9:14-29; Luke 9:37-43	Jesus rebukes a demon causing seizures, healing the boy.	Vaśitva, Īsitva	Vaśitva for demon control; Īsitva for bodily restoration.
28	Temple Tax in a Fish's Mouth	Matthew 17:24-27	Jesus instructs Peter to find a coin in a fish's mouth to pay taxes.	Prāpti, Prākāmya	Prāpti for obtaining the exact coin; Prākāmya for realizing the need.
29	Healing a Blind, Mute Demoniac	Matthew 12:22-23; Luke 11:14-23	Jesus heals a man possessed, blind, and mute.	Vaśitva, Īsitva	Vaśitva for exorcism; Īsitva for sensory healing.

30	Healing a Woman Crippled for 18 Years	Luke 13:10-17	Jesus lays hands on a bent-over woman, straightening her.	Īsitva	Lordship over long-term deformity.
31	Healing a Man with Dropsy	Luke 14:1-6	Jesus heals a man swollen with fluid on the Sabbath.	Īsitva	Control over bodily fluids and swelling.
32	Cleansing Ten Lepers	Luke 17:11-19	Jesus tells ten lepers to show themselves to priests; they are cleansed en route.	Īsitva	Lordship over skin diseases collectively.
33	Raising Lazarus from the Dead	John 11:1-45	Jesus calls Lazarus out of the tomb after four days dead.	Īsitva	Supreme control over death and decay.
34	Restoring Sight to Bartimaeus	Matthew 20:29-34; Mark 10:46-52; Luke 18:35-43	Jesus heals a blind beggar (or two) by command or touch.	Īsitva	Control over blindness.
35	Withering the Fig Tree	Matthew 21:18-22; Mark 11:12-14	Jesus curses a barren fig tree, which withers instantly.	Īsitva	Lordship over plant life and nature.
36	Healing a Servant's Severed Ear	Luke 22:50-51	Jesus touches and restores the ear of Malchus, cut off during arrest.	Īsitva	Control over wounds and regeneration.
37	Second Miraculous Catch of Fish	John 21:4-11	Post-resurrection, Jesus directs a massive catch of 153 fish.	Prāpti, Prākāmya	Prāpti for obtaining fish; Prākāmya for fulfilling the catch.
