Devotee: [indistinct]

Prabhupāda: Yes. It should be taken nicely. So that we shall forget eating all

nonsense.

Devotees: [Laughter]

Yamunā: Hare Kṛṣṇa!

Prabhupāda: Yes.

In this material world we find fault in everything. But we have to make progress in Kṛṣṇa consciousness. Yes. Because we are in a dangerous position of material existence. [Various sounds of preparation]..

Devotee (2): In the courtyard...

Devotee: Would you take an end of this?

Devotee (2): Lift it very slowly.. Yeah, that's right..

Devotee (3): Okay.

Devotee: Someone open up the door.

Devotee (3): Watch this.. There's some *prasādam* all over the floor....

Devotee (2): Okay go ahead..

Devotee: Okay let's go. [Drama as they proceed]

Devotee (2): Watch the prasāda.

Devotee: Put it down, put it down!

Devotee (2): The ply. [?]
